This small new house replaces a beloved 500sf family cabin "sent into town," sure to be re-loved by another family. The new cabin celebrates its connection to life outside at the waters edge; a lantern like bris-soliel capped porch is a true all season outdoor room served by its own fireplace, taking the chill off Northwest summer evenings and mild rainy days.

**structure**

Exposed glu-laminated timbers are grouped to form tree like columns with exposed joinery supporting a heavy beamed floor and a clerestory roof. The interior spaces are dominated by the warm natural coloration of the honest timber framing and wood ceilings.

**environment**

The compact footprint and efficient, cockpit-like interior spaces serve their functions well without gratuity. An active photovoltaic roof panel system offsets power consumption. Careful attention to natural daylighting and ventilation combined with a high efficiency radiant heating system helps make the house an inherently modest energy user.
